



Board of Elections and Voter

Registration, Fulton County

The Fulton County Voter Registration Office handles voter registration for all Fulton County residents regardless of the city or unincorporated area where they reside. You must be registered to vote in an election and you must be registered as a resident within the area in which you intend to vote. To vote in any election, you must be registered 29 days prior to the election date.

Once registered your precinct and polling location will be designated on your voter registration card. Fulton County also designates and manages the precinct boundaries and polling locations.

City Council

Roswell’s City Council is elected by the residents of Roswell to provide the vision and policy necessary to meet the needs of our citizens and community. Each Council Member serves “at large” with post assignments rather than being elected through single-member districts. It is the duty of the City Council to set policy for the City, to set millage rates for property taxes, to approve the annual City budget, to pass ordinances and to hear and act on requests for rezoning and annexation.

Council Meetings are held the second and fourth Monday in Council Chambers, Roswell City Hall, 38 Hill Street, 7 p.m. Work Sessions are convened on an as-needed basis. The fifth Monday, when it occurs, is an Open Forum meeting where citizens may address Mayor and Council on any concern.

What Can Be Recycled at the Roswell Recycling Center?

Plastic

- Plastic food and beverage containers numbered 1-7
- Plastic bags - grocery, dry cleaning, shopping and newspaper wrappers are accepted - no black bags, please
- Rinse containers thoroughly
- Labels and lids do not need to be removed
- No plastic buckets, storage containers, trash cans, laundry baskets or toys will be accepted

Glass

- Rinse glass jars, remove lids and separate by color
- Clear, brown and green food and beverage containers are accepted. Blue bottles can be put in with the green glass
- Labels do not need to be removed
- Not accepted - mirrors, crystal, drinking glasses, light bulbs, chinaware and glass from windows

Paper

- Newspaper - including glossy inserts. Remove the newspaper from sacks or bags before placing in the bin
- Do not bundle newspapers
- Office Paper - junk mail, adding machine tape, phone messages, colored paper, envelopes (including those with plastic windows), brochures, copy paper, newsletters, post-it-notes, paper with tape, lined legal pad or school tablet or notebook paper
- Computer Paper - green or white bar feeder type computer paper, shredded computer paper
- Magazines - share with friends and family before recycling or donate to public facilities
- Phone Books and White Paper Manuals - with glue and binding
- Regular cardboard and paperboard food containers - cereal boxes, shoe boxes, chip board, brown paper bags and gift wrap
- Corrugated Cardboard - moving boxes, etc.
- Hard Back Books/Paperback Books - special bins are provided for these items, as they are donated to the Friends of the Alpharetta Library
- Text books
- No plastic or wax coated cartons, food contaminated paper or cardboard, paper towels, tissues, napkins or aseptic packaging

Metal

- Metal should be clean and separated into Ferrous or Non-Ferrous
- Ferrous contains iron which is

magnetic. Food containers, metal lids to glass containers, metal hangers and many appliances

- Non-Ferrous is non-magnetic. Grills, copper tubing, plumbing materials, electric wire, brass keys or fixtures, aluminum siding, shed doors and lead weights
- Aluminum-drink cans and foil. Separate cans from other aluminum items. Includes beer/soda cans, aluminum plates and foil.

Miscellaneous

- Batteries (automotive and rechargeable, UPS)
- Cell phones and accessories
- Printer Cartridges
- Electronics (computer equipment and accessories, stereos, personal copiers, printers, VCRs, DVD players, digital cameras, camcorders, speakers, fax machines, projectors, typewriters and scanners)


