

Part Time Reserve Officer – This is general law enforcement work responsible for protecting life and property, enforcing laws and ordinances, responding to emergencies, apprehending and arresting individuals, conducting crime scene investigations, and performing other public safety functions. Work assignments may include patrol duty, traffic enforcement or other areas. Work involves an element of personal danger.

Must be U.S. citizen, minimum age 21 years, valid Georgia drivers license, high school diploma or GED certificate, honorable discharge if served in the Armed Forces. Must successfully pass cognitive skills examination and personality assessment. Visual ability cannot be less than 20/100 in each eye, uncorrected, and must be corrected to a 20/20 with glasses or contact lenses. Medical examination required upon offer of employment. In order to ensure the highest probability of success, a pre-employment physical abilities test is required of all applicants. Applicants can not be employed full time with another Police agency. Must be a resident of Georgia. Applicants must be in good standing with Georgia POST Council. Must be Georgia Certified Police Officer.
