Description:

The instructors must attend scheduled classes, dress rehearsals and recitals as needed in April/May to provide backstage support. Weekly classes may be offered if available.

Requirements:

A college degree is highly preferred; however, a high school diploma is the minimum requirement. Prior relevant professional experience is highly preferred. The physical ability to effectively dance, and provide demonstration is required. Must be energetic, responsible, dependable, have their own transportation & have the ability to multi-task. Exercising **exceptional** customer service to effectively communicate with staff, participants and parents is essential.
